

SAFEGUARDING CODE OF CONDUCT

This card contains essential information for all Girls Assemble colleagues and volunteers.

When working with Children, Young People or Adults at Risk:

DO...

- 1. DO Take all reasonable steps to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those in contact with Girls Assemble.
- 2. DO Report all allegations, suspicions and concerns immediately.
- 3. DO Keep a written record of any safeguarding incident, allegation or concern, in line with Girls Assemble's safeguarding policies.
- 4. DO Communicate in a way that is respectful and appropriate to age, understanding and preference.
- 5. DO Ensure your behaviour, language, gestures and clothing are appropriate and above reproach.
- 6. DO Ensure that the focus of any work or volunteering remains based on work or volunteering and not on becoming friends.
- 7. DO Make yourself aware of any behaviour or relationship difficulties involving those you are working with.

DON'T...

- 1. DON'T Put yourself in a compromising situation, such as by spending a lot of time with a child, which could result in an allegation.
- 2. DON'T Offer to do things of a personal nature for anyone who is capable of doing these for themselves.
- 3. DON'T Exchange any personal contact information of any kind with children, young people or adults at risk. If you receive a friend request from a child, young person or adult at risk via a social network, do not accept the request and inform your line manager or staff supervisor.
- 4. DON'T Make sexually suggestive comments.
- 5. DON'T Have inappropriate physical or verbal contact e.g. engage in rough, physical or sexually provocative behaviour nor any form of inappropriate touching or language.
- 6. DON'T Tolerate bullying, rule violations or use of prohibited substances.
